RESOLUTION NO. 50-14

CAMDEN COUNTY INSURANCE FUND COMMISSION AMENDING DESIGNATION OF OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER FOR THE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the CAMDEN COUNTY INSURANCE FUND COMMISSION (hereinafter the Commission) is duly constituted as a joint insurance fund and subject to certain requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law and the Open Public Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2014, the Commission adopted Resolution No.: 9-14 designating the Philadelphia Inquirer and the Courier-Post as the official newspapers of the Commission through re-organization of the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the costs for placement of legal notices in the Philadelphia Inquirer have risen beyond the budgeted amount for this purpose for Commission Fund Year 2014-2015; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to New Jersey law, the Commission may advertise all legal notices in the Courier-Post newspaper and the costs for the same are within the Commission budget; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners desire to omit the Philadelphia Inquirer as an official newspaper of the Commission; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Camden County Insurance Fund Commission, (hereinafter the Commission) that the Philadelphia Inquirer is hereby omitted as an official newspaper of the Commission, and the Courier Post shall be the sole designated official newspaper for the Commission, and that all official notices required to be published shall be published in the Courier-Post newspaper.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the designation of official newspaper shall be effective upon adoption of the within resolution for the remainder of the Commission term through the 2015 re-organization of the Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the case of special meetings or emergency meetings, the Secretary or Assistant Secretary of the Commission shall give notice of said meetings to the Courier Post.
